What is campus hazardous waste?

Campus hazardous waste is any product labeled as poison, corrosive, toxic, flammable, combustible, or irritant that is used ***within your workplace at CSUF*** and is no longer useful or wanted; this waste may be harmful to human health and/or the environment.

Have you ever wondered how to properly dispose of or get rid of any of the following examples of hazardous waste?

- Solvents (gas, antifreeze)
- Fluorescent light tubes & bulbs
- Sharps or used needles
- Aerosol cans
- Paints, batteries or oil/lubricants
- Asbestos
- Bug spray, pesticides/insecticides/herbicides
- Mercury Thermometers
